The 2017 Bourgogne Blanc Les Champs l'Huillier is terrific, wafting from the glass with aromas of lemon oil, grapefruit pith and oatmeal. On the palate, it's medium to full-bodied, elegantly textural and tangy, with more depth and concentration than the Louères. It's a serious Bourgogne Blanc that over-performs for the price. (WK)
