Notes of lilac and violet perfume ruddier tones of baked plum and cherry on the nose of this wine. Black-fruit flavors are opulent and ripe but balanced by brisk acidity and fine, persistent tannins that leave chalky freshness on the finish. Lovely now for its unctuous, primary fruit, the wine should develop savory complexities through 2035 and hold further. (AI)
