Pale gold. Expressive, mineral-accented aromas of fresh pear, Meyer lemon and tarragon pick up hints of iodine and jasmine with air. Juicy and seamless in texture, offering densely packed orchard and citrus fruit flavors that are sharpened and lifted by a refreshingly bitter quinine accent. Finishes minerally, taut and very long, leaving citrus pith and honeysuckle notes behind. (93 points)
