Limpid straw color. Meyer lemon, pear, pungent flowers and a gingery nuance on the perfumed, mineral-accented nose. Honeysuckle flavors, penetrating orchard and citrus fruit show impressive depth as well as energy and fine delineation. Becomes deeper with air and finishes broad and long, with building spiciness and a bracing jolt of smoky minerality. (93-94 points)
