Black raspberry, creamy licorice, toast and spice all flow from the 2013 Cornas, and it has full-bodied power, sweet tannin and integrated acidity. Aged 16 months in new demi-muids, enjoy this polished, elegant and seamless beauty through 2028. Johann Michel continues to produce brilliant wines from the steep, granite infused slopes of Cornas. Both his 2012s, which I raved about last year, and his 2013s are some of the most successful in appellation. **Drink 2014–2028**
