An outstanding example of a 100% Chenin Blanc from the small yet compact appellation of Savennieres, these wines can age well, but there is no reason to defer your gratification. Medium-bodied with a wonderful flowery, melony character as well as hints of honeysuckle and beeswax, this fragrant 2010 Savennieres possesses crisp acidity, penetrating flavors, and a dry, heady, mineral-laced finish.
