Montlouis les Pions



In 2008, Ludovic Chanson took over a 6.5 ha property in Montlouis, a small AOC that sits on the left bank of the Loire River opposite Vouvray, just east of the city of Tours. It had been organically farmed since 2006 and is at this date Certified Organic. The property is primarily planted to Chenin Blanc, however there are also small plots of both Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay.

Grape varietals: 100% Chenin Blanc

Location: Husseau

Quantity produced: 6000 bottles

Soil: clay, “perruches” on silex

Exposure: South

Area: 1.2 ha

Age of the vineyard: 20 to 45 years

Agricultural method: organic certified

Pruning: Gobelet

Harvest: manual

Vinification: in stainless steel tank. No enzymes, no added yeast, no added sugar, no fining.

Alcohol content: 13%

Residual Sugar: 1.1 g/l

Acidity: 3.9 g/l

Food & Wine: Aperitif, cheese

Aging potential: 4 years
