A slightly more elegant and cooler nose offers even better complexity with its higher-toned nose of red berry liqueur, earth, pepper and spice elements. There is good richness and the old vines definitely are in evidence along with a subtle minerality on the lingering and slightly finer finale. Like the Corentin this beautifully well-balanced effort could easily be enjoyed now yet the pieces are in place such that this should be capable of rewarding 6 to 8 years of cellaring.
