The 2018 Juffer-Sonnenuhr Spätlese is a touch riper in profile than its counterpart from Wehlen. The nose wafts from the glass in a lovely blend of pear, white cherry, bee pollen, gentle smokiness, a nice base of soil and a topnote of cress. On the palate the wine is fullish, round and nicely creamy on the attack, with a fine core, very good focus and grip and zesty acids adding brightness and bounce on the long and succulent finish. Another very tasty bottle of Spätlese.
